

# Wakefield 0-19 Service

## Health Visiting, School Nursing, FNP and 5-19 years Immunisations

During the COVID-19 period, we are continuing to provide a service but we have had to make a few temporary changes to how we do this.

### Telephone Service

The 0-19 Service are still very much here to support the health and wellbeing of everyone in your family and continue to be available for breastfeeding, weaning, bedwetting, child development and emotional difficulties. We are very much available to support Children, Young People and Families who may have specific needs during this time and may require support either virtually or in person. Any child, young person, parent, or carer can call Monday to Friday, 9am to 5pm, on **01924 310130** for advice and support.

### We will continue to provide the following:

- **Antenatal contact from the health visiting service**  
By telephone or video call but sometimes may be in person.   
- **Birth contact from the health visiting service**  
In person for all families but sometimes by telephone or video call.   
- **6 – 8 week review from the health visiting service**  
By telephone or video call but sometimes may be in person.   
- **12-16 week review from the health visiting service**  
By telephone or video call but sometimes may be in person.   
- **Ongoing support for those known to services**  
By telephone, video call, or in person where required.   
- **Emotional support for young people**  
By telephone or video call.  
- **Vaccinations and Immunisations for children**  
Children aged 0-5 years will receive contact from their GP. Children aged 5-19 years will receive contact from the team if their immunisation is due. The team can be contacted on **01924 310133**.

### We are working to restore the following:

- Routine development reviews at 9-12 month and 2-2.5 year
- School screening and drop-in clinics
